Required documents

- Scan of valid passport with personal details.
- Scan of an authenticated copy of the degree certificate for the profession and possible area of expertise. Programme listing the courses from your professional degree, divided into theoretical and practical subjects.
- Indicate how much time was spent on the education in these subjects. This document must be issued by the institution from which you received your degree.
- Supporting documents showing any professional experience.
- A recent curriculum vitae (CV).
- Lists of marks and assessments of study results, practice periods or internships, etc.
- Certificate of Current Professional Status (CCPS) of the country of certification and all countries where you have worked or lived for more than three months. This document must not be older than three months. You do not need to supply CCPS from the Netherlands.
- If you also want to apply for an exemption for a specific area of expertise, but you do not have a registered specialism (Article 14 of the BIG Act) in the BIG register, you must provide supporting documents for the assessment of the area of expertise.
- Proof of entry in a professional register (if one exists in the country of origin). This document may be no older than 6 months.

In the explanatory memorandum you will find information about the requirements that are set for the various documents.
